## **GENERAL REGULATIONS**

#### 1. INVITATION

The European Chess Union (E.C.U), the International School Chess Union (I.S.C.U.) and the Olympic Sports Academy of Thessaloniki have the honour of inviting all National Chess Federations of the European Chess Union and eligible players to the **European School Championships 2014** organised in Kavala, Greece from **16 June (arrivals)** to **27 June (departures)**.

### 2. PARTICIPATION - AGE LIMITS

- 2.1. Each National Federation or School Association or schools may enter an unlimited number of players in each of the **12 age groups**. In case that one girl group has less than 10 participants, it will be merged with the same open age group category.
- 2.2. Entitled to participate are players (Boys & Girls) who shall not have reached the age:

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Of 7, by 1st January 2014 (date of birth – January 1st, 2007 and after) – Tournament Under 7; Of 9, by 1st January 2014 (date of birth – January 1st, 2005 and after) – Tournament Under 9; Of 11, by 1st January 2014 (date of birth – January 1st, 2003 and after) – Tournament Under 11; Of 13, by 1st January 2014 (date of birth – January 1st, 1999 and after) – Tournament Under 15; Of 17, by 1st January 2014 (date of birth – January 1st, 1997 and after) – Tournament Under 17;
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Upon arrival, captains or players may be requested to present the passports of their players for verification of age eligibility.

2.3. Accommodation and travel expenses will be covered by the participants, federations, schools and their Sponsors. Delegations of players must be accompanied <u>at least by one adult</u> (chief, coach or parent), who is taking care about the travel details.

#### 3. ENTRY - FEES

- 3.1. <u>A registration fee of 30 euros per participant</u> (players, officials, trainers, media, etc.) should be paid directly to the Organizing Committee.
- 3.2 **ECU entry fee:** In accordance with the ECU regulations, an ECU entry fee of 20 EUR is required for each player. National Federations should send this amount directly to the ECU account or it can be paid to the Organizing Committee before the start of the first round.

**3.3.** Participants from the European Small Nations (FIDE Zone 1.10) have a 50% discount on registration and transportation fees.

#### 4. REGISTRATION AND TRAVEL CONDITIONS

- 4.1 Entry forms must be sent <u>by the National Federations or the players</u> and returned to the Organizing Committee not later than **Friday 2 May 2014.** If the registration form is not forwarded by the Federation a copy must be sent to the National Federation.
- 4.2 The complete registration form must include the surname/s, first name/s, FIDE ID number, FIDE rating and passport number (<u>for visa only purpose</u>) of each player and each accompanying person. It must also include the name and telephone/e-mail/fax number **of the Chief of Delegation**.
- 4.3 The cost of bus transportation from Kavala airport (30 km) to the tournament hotels with return on the departure day is 40 EUR per person.

The cost of bus transportation from the Thessaloniki International Airport (150 km) to the tournament hotels with return on the departure day is 70 EUR per person

4.4 At the time of registration by Friday 2 May 2014, the amount of 30 euros (registration) + 30% of the total accommodation cost + 40 euros transportation cost from Kavala Airport or 70 euros transportation cost from Thessaloniki (if required) must be transferred, free of bank charges, to the following bank account of the Organizing Committee for each participant or accompanying person. Rest of payments must be made upon arrival.

#### 5. VENUE - ACCOMMODATION

- 5.1 Accommodation and board will be provided at Galaxy Hotel (4 star) and Lucy Hotel (5 stars). Playing Hall is the City Conference Hall in walking distance.
- 5.2 **Every player is obliged to lodge at the official hotels.** Every accompanying person that requests a visa from the Organizing Committee is obliged to lodge at the official hotels. Bookings are made **only through the Organizing Committee** (through registrations and bookings forms).
- 5.3 Hotel payments for all players and accompanying persons must be made 30% in advance as described in registration process and the rest upon arrival, the latest. Hotel payments must be paid in euros (EUR). No future payments of hotel bills will be accepted. Cancellations are not possible after Friday 16 May 2014.
- 5.4 Lodging for players, coaches and accompanying persons will **cost per person for 9 and 10 <u>nights</u>** (includes breakfast, lunch and dinner in buffet): <u>For 11 nights</u> or more nights <u>add the charge of one or more nights</u>.

### 6. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 6.1 The tournament will be played according to the Swiss System in 9 rounds. National ratings will not be taken into consideration for the pairings. Rate of play will be according to FIDE regulations 90 minutes for 40 moves plus 30 minutes for the rest of the game with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move 1.
- 6.2 Communication between players (the offer of draw) is forbidden until the 40th move has been played.
